2. **It's Time For My Reminder About Boat Registration!** In case you have forgotten they are due annually in June. Washington State Department of Licensing no longer sends out reminders you just need to remember that by June of every year they are due.

This is how the law reads: To navigate, operate, employ, or "**MOOR**" your vessel in Washington, you must have a Washington title, registration card, and registration decals. What this means is **EVEN IF YOUR BOAT NEVER LEAVES THE MARINA** you need a current registration sticker on the hull of the boat and the registration numbers must be in compliance. Documented vessels do not display registration numbers, but you still need a current registration sticker on the hull. At least that is what the rules say although most documented vessels put the sticker in a window and that seems to satisfy any inspection.

3. I know this sounds like a repeat from last month and it is. With the boat ramp construction and **MINES** floating around I have been a little busy. None the less all of these things are worthy of repeating. This will also be the last time that BAD will be mentioned in the newsletter for about 6 months. Please donate and volunteer for BAD.
