Happy 100th Birthday Port of Brownsville!

At the first Port Commission Meeting of the year the Commissioners passed Resolution 20-01 acknowledging the 100 – Year Anniversary of the Port of Brownsville. The Port of Brownsville was established by election on June 1, 1920 and consisted of a single dock which served the Mosquito Fleet.



Today, the Port has 10,926 registered voters and a total of 353 slips, 48 with boathouses and is called home to 33 live aboard tenants.
