Assured about Insurance

Port staff has compiled a list of vessels that have not provided current insurance, or that have expired registration stickers on the vessel. A large number of letters were sent out to owners to address this. If you have not already done so, please address this issue right away. We do need for your boat to be insured and the Port of Brownville must be named as additional insured on the policy to comply with our requirements.

Security

Crime and vandalism are on the rise in Kitsap County. Other area Ports as well as businesses and residents are reporting more and more issues in our community. While we can't prevent every incident, we can try to be aware of the times and take what measures we can.

The Port has a security contractor who is present every evening walking about the parking areas and marina. While we do have some security cameras now, we have been building a fund to upgrade the camera system which will include more cameras and more coverage in the parking lot and waterfront areas.

Main Pier

The piling refurbishment project has been completed which includes addressing 12 of the piles that were showing signs of significant decay as well as new cross bracing and a new light pole bracket for Moon #3 on the main pier. This is expected to be a long-term repair that will last for many years

Electronic Payment Kiosk

The Port is installing 2 new electronic pay stations for guest moorage and boat ramp usage. We feel this will make a more efficient system and hopefully increase convenience for all our visitors!
