Kiosk Covers, we have ordered and are waiting for the covers for the kiosks. These should be sometime in the 2nd week of September, and you will be seeing staff out and about beginning installation of these.

CERB Grant, we have signed the grant paperwork with CERB and are working on finalizing our agreement with the company that will be conducting the study. Over the next few months, we will be getting more information on how the community will be involved in this project. We don't have it yet, but stay tuned, we are just beginning.

Fiber Internet, I think many of you have seen our Port Manager running around with several different services getting quotes to bring fiber internet to the port as part of our RCO Boating Infrastructure Grant. We haven't selected a service yet, but we are hoping to have the project completed by the end of December. This is your Dedicated Fees Dollars at work!
