We wanted to keep you updated on some other items that have happened for the Port in the last Month.

Kiosk Covers- Thanks to the hard work of the Port Maintenance Team we have installed the first of the kiosk covers to help protect the investment made in the kiosk payment systems. We will be working on the details for the breakwater kiosk as the winter starts to move in.

CERB Grant – We have begun to provide documents on former projects, and ideas to the CERB contractor to inspire and better understand what our Port is and what might work best. Over the next few months, we will be getting more information on how the community will be involved in this project. We don't have it yet, but stay tuned, we are just beginning.

Fiber Internet - We haven't selected a service yet, but we are hoping to have the project completed by the end of December. We are in the process of ensuring that all the needed components are there to make a smooth project before we jump in headfirst. It is our hope that by adding fiber internet we will be able to supply a higher quality internet as well as upgrade our camera systems. This is your Dedicated Fees Dollars at work!
